Modern Foreign Languages - Year 5 and Year 6

Below are the modern foreign language units that children will study across Year 3 and Year 4 at The Rydal Academy. The language they will be learning is French. They are split into half terms or terms depending on the length of the unit. There is a brief explanation of each focus area and suggestions for activities that you can do with your child at home to support their learning.

Autumn 1	Children will begin to learn vocabulary about different foods, give opinions about foods and learn phrases to enable them to go grocery shopping. Children will be given the opportunity to extend their vocabulary by studying Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Children will then learn their numbers to 31 and months of the year. They will then use this to be able to ask and say when their birthday is and other important dates to them.	This year will begin with children learning about the different equipment in the classroom, and school subjects. Children will practise how to say what their favourite/least favourite subject is. They will also study the traditional tale The Tortoise's Birthday, consolidating the vocabulary that they have learnt from the previous years. This term also consists of learning about more traditional tales to develop their vocabulary, reading and their listening skills. These include "The Sun and the Wind" and 'The Fox and the Crow'.	Children will learn about different homes, and what rooms are in their home. They will be able to describe their home and use comparative language to compare. Children will then learn how to give directions and use them to direct their friends to different places in town. In the town, children will learn how to read menus order food in the café.
